

## ***IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR CUTTERS***

---

The West Gippsland Quarter Horse Association at their July committee meeting adopted a new policy for taking entries for the cuttings held at their monthly shows at Cannibal Creek Reserve, North Garfield. Since the formation of the Association in the early 1980's, it was possible for entries to be phoned through by the Thursday night prior to the Sunday show. Due to the much larger volume of entries over recent years, and also due to many entries which have been phoned through not being paid for on show day, it has been decided that ***“ all entries must be made via completed WGQHA official entry form, accompanied with cheque for full payment of entries and be mailed to the WGQHA Show Secretary P/O Box 110 Pakenham 3812 Vic . Entries must be received by the Wednesday prior to the Sunday Show. No late entries will be taken “***

THIS REQUIREMENT WILL BE IMPLEMENTED FOR THE SEPTEMBER 2007 SHOW.

NCHA Rule 4. re Show committee reads that.....

The entry fee payable in respect of each horse entered shall be paid at the time of lodgement of application for entry.....**ALL ENTRY FEES AND CATTLE HIRE MUST BE PAID PRIOR TO COMPETING IN THE RELEVANT COMPETITION.**

All show entry forms for Cutting and other Performance events are provided in the monthly WGQHA Newsletter.

From time to time, important information for WGQHA members is published in the **Monthly Newsletter** which is posted to all members prior to each months Show.

All cutting horse competitors are invited to join the West Gippsland Quarter Horse Association. This will not only keep you up to date with the latest news but will also be greatly appreciated by the WGQHA committee.

Since the formation of the WGQHA in the 1980's it has been definite policy to conduct cuttings at each of their monthly shows

The constant work required in maintaining the cutting arena to provide the best possible conditions for competition for 12 cutting shows per year does come at quite a financial cost annually
