

RULES & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY.

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

1. Faxed entries will only be accepted if proof of electronic payment is provided.
2. Office Fee: \$10:00 per Horse.
3. Camping sites are free for competitors. Ground entry is free for all. Spectators BYO seating.
4. Performance classes are open to all breeds. All halter horses must be registered with their relevant breed societies.
5. Copies of Registration & Amateur permits must accompany entry forms.
6. No pending registrations will be accepted as per AQHA ruling.
7. All Prize money is guaranteed in all Feature Challenge Events.
8. All prize monies will be paid out to 4th place on a 40%, 30%, 20%, 10% basis, to be collected and signed for no longer than 2 hours after the conclusion of last event entered. Cheques will be made out to the owner of the horse. No monies will be mailed. Any uncollected prize monies will be deemed as a donation to WGQHA.
9. Please ensure the waiver form is signed and must accompany your entry form
10. One set of back numbers will be issued per horse. If the horse has a different rider/exhibitor combination a separate entry form must be filled out. A fee of \$5:00 will be charged for back numbers and will be refundable at the conclusion of competition. Back numbers are to be worn on the riders back, or each side of the saddle blanket.
11. The All Breed Halter Maturity is open to all sexes 4 years & over.
12. Entrants in the Yearling Lunge-Line must state on the entry form if the Yearling is deemed a Pleasure or Hunter prospect. (ie: P or H)
13. Youth competitors are requested (if applicable) to asterisk the names of two horses that are to be tabulated toward hi-point.
14. A \$15.00 Insurance levy will apply to any competitor who is a non AQHA or non affiliated AQHA member.
15. Any protest must be lodged in writing with a \$30.00 fee. If the protest is upheld money will be refunded. Any dispute will be dealt with by the show committee, and their decision is final.
16. Breaks between classes (ie lunch) will be decided by the show committee on the day and will be well announced.
17. A refund of entries will only be considered upon receipt of a vet certificate stating why the horse was unfit for competition. Office fees will be non refundable. A vet will be on call for the duration of the show.
18. No horses shall be left tied to floats, trees or any railing fences overnight.
19. Training equipment of any kind is disallowed one hour prior to the show starting and until one hour after the show concludes.
20. No competitor or their connections shall approach the Judge personally at anytime (no exceptions).
21. Any changes of horse rider/handler combination must be registered with the show secretaries office a minimum of 30 minutes before commencement of that entered event.
22. Points from Open, Feature, 2& 3 year old classes will not be tabulated for high point awards
23. The AQHA statement on animal welfare will be clearly posted and adhered to. All horses are to be treated with respect and in a humane manner.
24. Trade Stalls are welcome free. Please make arrangements with WGQHA Committee prior to show.
25. Catering & amenities are available on the grounds. Please dispose of your rubbish into receptacles provided.
26. All competitors, spectators, vendors, & caterers attend at their own risk. The WGQHA will not be held liable for any injury, theft, loss or damage from whatsoever cause arising.
27. No dogs will be permitted to roam free. They must be under strict control of their owners at all times.
